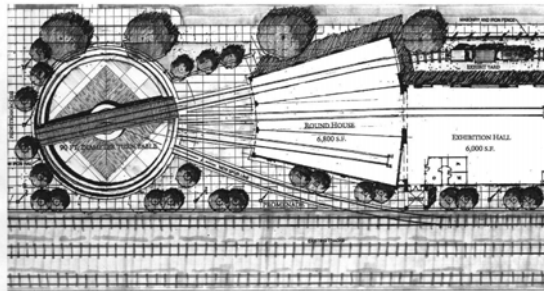
HELPING HANDS
